- All scholarship holders are expected to display exemplary attitude, maintain high standards of academic achievement and behaviour and to contribute positively and enthusiastically to all aspects of College life.

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to an interview with the Principal/Head of School for further consideration, prior to the end of Term 3.

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The awarding of scholarships shall be determined on merit at the discretion of the College Principal and relevant Head of School and based on the information provided in this application.
