



SUMMARY OF CHANGES:

Sports Uniform Changes

Progressive phasing out of the charcoal sports uniform fabric over a period of time.

- a. Future sports shorts for all year levels will be black in a standard colour fabric, with no stripes, just white block lettering NAVIGATOR as per the current track pants. These shorts will be phased in, and made available in Year 6 each year, as from the start of 2018.
- b. A new design sports polo top will be introduced as the charcoal fabric replacement. This will be introduced as a year by year process, starting in Year 6 only, for 2018.
- c. Year 4 and 5 students will continue to wear the striped polo tops for PE until such time as stock levels make it possible to switch to the new sports top.
- d. All other year levels from Year 7 – 12 in 2018 to continue wearing the current charcoal tops in order to reduce stock levels and use up the remaining charcoal fabric (200 meters).
- e. Track pants and sports jackets will be changed from charcoal to black as current stock levels determine.

New Sports Uniform - EFFECTIVE COMMENCING Term one 2018 (YEAR 6 ONLY)

Year 6 students - to wear black shorts and new PE sports top

All other year levels to wear existing sports uniform in 2018

Year 2 – 5 striped top & navy or charcoal shorts

Year 7 – 12 charcoal top and shorts

The new sports uniform will be phased in each year in Year 6 until 2024 or until such times as stocks of charcoal fabric are depleted i.e.

- EFFECTIVE COMMENCING Term one 2019 (YEAR 6 - 7 ONLY)
- EFFECTIVE COMMENCING Term one 2020 (YEAR 6 - 8 ONLY)

Other Changes

1. Junior School Uniform - EFFECTIVE COMMENCING Term One 2019

There will be a future extension of the current Reception to Year 1 Uniform through to Year 2 and 3. This extension will commence with the 2019 Year 2 students and be completed in 2020 with all Reception to Year 3 students wearing the same uniform.

2. Year 12 Grey Woolen Jumpers – EFFECTIVE COMMENCING Term One 2018

Due to a change in policy with regard to the wearing of the annual student-designed Year 12 Jumper, the grey woolen jumpers for Year 12 Students as an additional uniform requirement will be phased out as from the end of 2017, with a significant cost saving to parents.

3. Sports Shoe specifications - EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

Sports shoes will be aligned across the whole College removing the current practice of four different sports shoe colour policies from ELC to Year 12.

Sports shoes for ALL students must be an approved sports sandshoes/cross trainer style (without colour restrictions). Basketball boots, novelty shoes e.g. flashing lights, licenced pictures, wheels ARE NOT ALLOWED

4. Pants - EFFECTIVE COMMENCING Term One 2018

Grey pants be included as an optional item of winter uniform for girls from Year 4 – Year 12. (Can be worn instead of the winter skirt). In the first instance Navigator College will not hold stock of these items but will make available an annual special order for those who wish to purchase pants for girls.

5. Sports Socks - EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

In the interests of consistency, sports socks are to be white with black & gold stripe and the College name, for all students ELC – Year 12. (existing blue & gold striped socks may be worn until stocks are depleted)

6. When to wear PE Uniform - EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

All students across the College, may wear their sports uniform to and from school on the day on which their PE practical class is held. This particularly affects senior school students, who will no longer be required to change into PE uniform at school and change back into formal uniform at the end of the PE lesson.

The fully revised and updated policy has been posted on our web site.

In general, until such times as your existing uniforms need to be replaced, the current uniform may continue to be worn. The only exception to this is at year 6 level (each year from 2018), where the new sports shorts and polo top will be required. Note that Year 6 students in any case are currently required to buy a new polo top to replace the striped polo sports tops that are worn through to the end of Year 5.
